County Health Rankings	Asotin County Ranks 22 <sup>nd</sup> in State in Health Outcomes; 17 <sup>th</sup> in State in Health Factors. Rankings based on variety of data sources, including BRFSS, NCHS, CDC, USDA	
Vaping Bill	SB 6328-- It is important to note this bill DOES preempt local health's licensing/fee authority, however, we retain our local authority to regulate "use" both indoor and outdoor. Probably the strongest vaping bill in the nation, from a Public Health perspective. This bill has not been voted on as yet. There is a state level law regarding fees for state to regulate and license. Vaping stores already existing will have to comply with new law. Enforcement will come from liquor and cannabis funds.
